Tools Needed For Assembly:

Screwdriver
Level

Assembly Tips:

Some drawings or images in this manual may not look exactly like your product. Please read and understand the text before starting each assembly step.

Using wood glue (included) to glue the joints after assembly will provide a stronger bond to the product.

If you are using an electric screw driver in assembly, please set at low torque and do not overtighten the hardware.











Care:

Apply lemon oil with a soft cotton cloth. Do not use products with silicones. This may cause damage to the finish. Never let the wood get in contact with any type of paint remover.

Connections:

Changes in temperature and humidity will cause the wood to dry out possibly causing the bolts loosen. Check the bolts periodically to make sure they are still tight. DO NOT put your wood game piece directly against hot radiators or sources of heat. Doing this may cause the wood to dry and crack.

Step 1

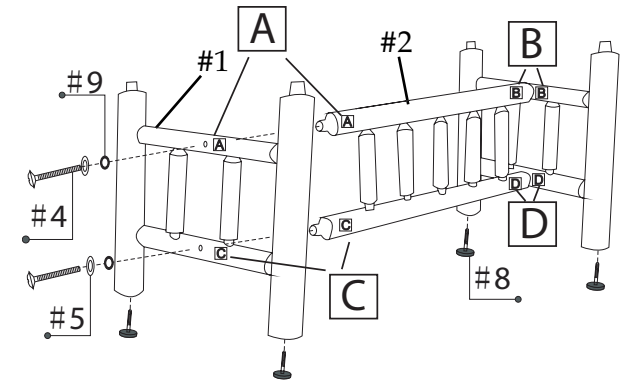
Lay leg panel I (#1) on the floor with the holes for the leg panel II (#2) facing up. **NOTE:** Leg panels are labeled A, B, C, D on each end. Please correspond with stickers. See diagram.

Step 2

Brush the pointed end of leg panel II (#2) with wood glue (#10), push it into the holes on the leg panel I (#1). When all three panels are firmly fitted, attach pieces with bolts (#4), white washers (#5) and washers (#9). Do not completely tighten leg panels until step 4 is completed.

Step 3

Screw the leg levelers (#8) to the bottom of the legs.



Step 4

Brush glue on the pointed end of legs, Lay table top (#3) on top of assembled legs, tighten with screws (#6). Using wood caps (#7) with glue (#10) to fill the holes.
